

Van Cleef Engineering and Borough of Flemington Win Municipal Engineering Project of the Year Award for Construction Management

Flemington, NJ – The New Jersey Society of Municipal Engineers (NJSME) has announced that the Borough of Flemington and Van Cleef Engineering Associates, LLC (VCEA) will receive a Municipal Engineering Project of the Year Award for Construction Management at the New Jersey League of Municipalities on November 16, 2011.

The winning project involves the improvement of a culvert on Park Avenue, in the Borough of Flemington. Project Manager Robert Martucci, P.E., C.M.E, prepared permitting applications, finalized plans and specifications, and oversaw the project through the construction phase.

Borough Engineer Robert Clerico, P.E., C.M.E., a partner at VCEA, was also involved in the project. “We want to congratulate the Borough of Flemington and Rob Martucci for winning this award. The Park Avenue project represents the commitment of VCEA’s municipal engineers in providing exceptional service for our clients,” stated Mr. Clerico.

The Park Avenue Improvement Project, completed in August 2011, consists of an 1,800 foot long precast segmented concrete box culvert. The project also included a realignment of Park Avenue with Walter Foran Boulevard, as well as traffic signal installation. The project had several sources of funding, including NJDOT Local Aid, Federal Highway and American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Aid, as well as Hunterdon County and Borough Funds. VCEA was responsible for permitting, procuring the right of way adjustments for the realigned roadway, finalizing the plans and specifications, as well as the construction observation and management of the project.
